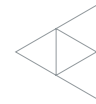

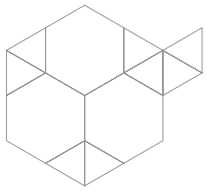




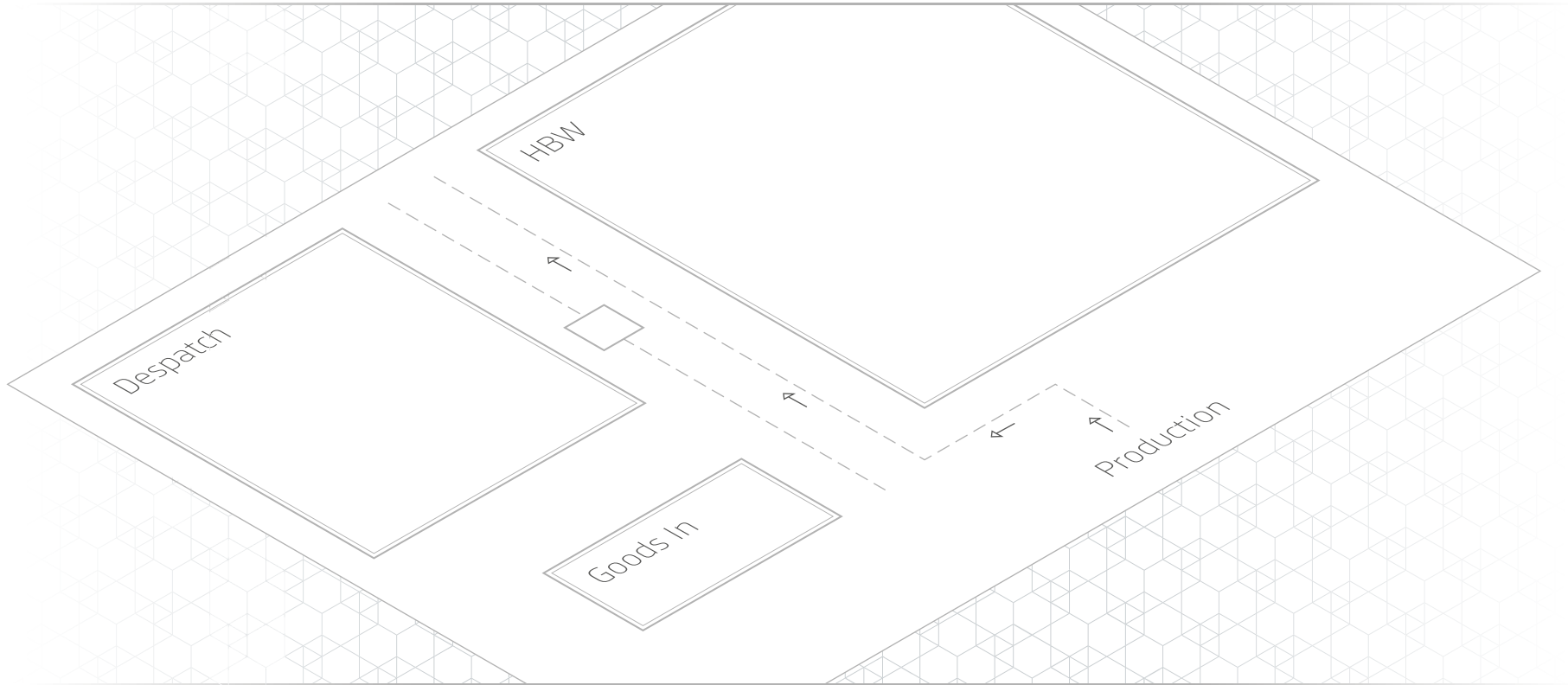
## PURPOSE

- > The brewery invested 2016 in a **modern high-bay warehouse** at the city center in Mannheim, Germany.
- > Therefore the customer is able to operate the warehouse **without a single operator** (except truck loading).
- > The new 27-metre high high-bay warehouse provides the company with the ability to **enlarge their storage capacities without enlarging the footprint**.
- > The whole project was **planned and realized** by **System Logistics GmbH** as general contractor.





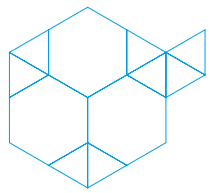

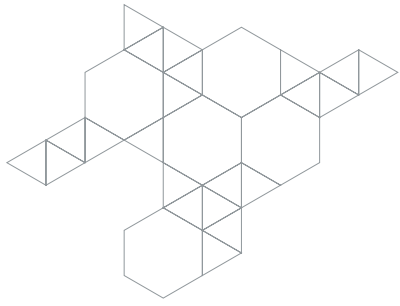

## HIGH-BAY WAREHOUSE

- > 3 aisle, fully automated, multi-deep, 14,408 pallet locations
- > 130 pallets/h out, 70 pallets/h in
- > 3 cranes with 2 load handling devices (each)
- > Direct Connection to a Production line
- > Fully automated half pallet deslaving
- > Automated labeling with a robot
- > Project Lead time 18 months



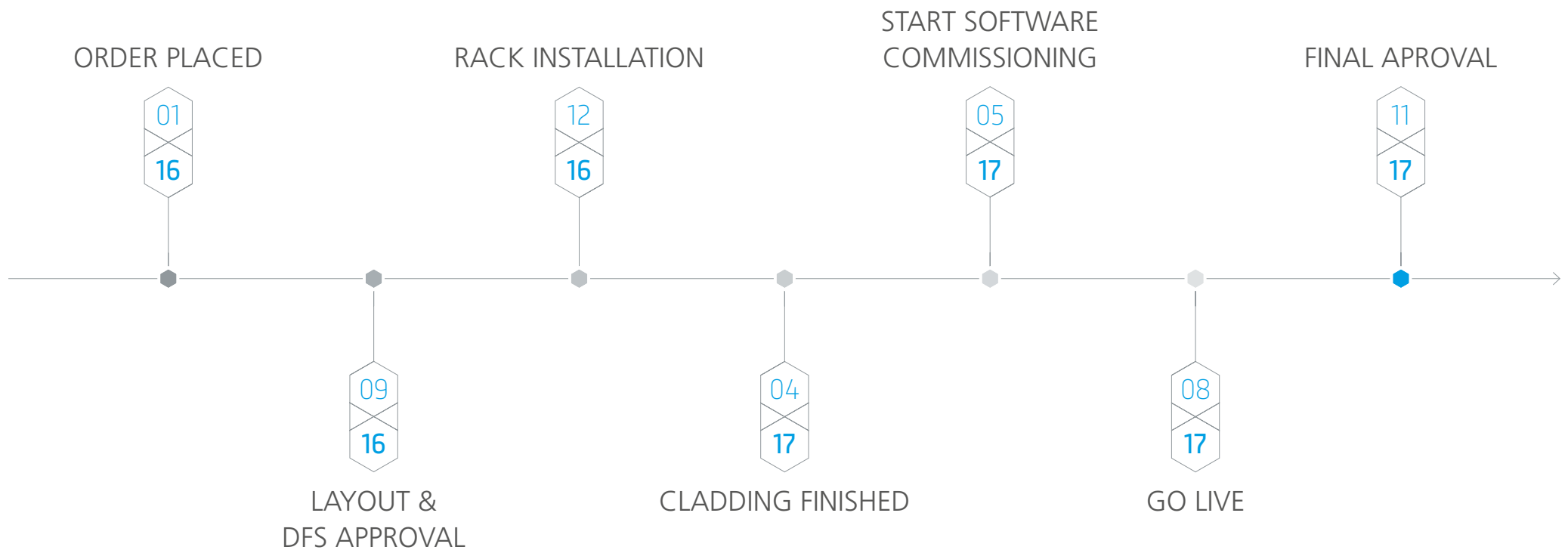
## HIGHLIGHTS

- > Direct connection to a production line
- > Fully-automated half-pallet nut remover
- > Transformation of manually operated intralogistics to a fully-automated and integrated value chain
- > Maximisation of storage density due to pressures from considerable lack of floor
- > Space Construction of a high-bay warehouse in the city centre



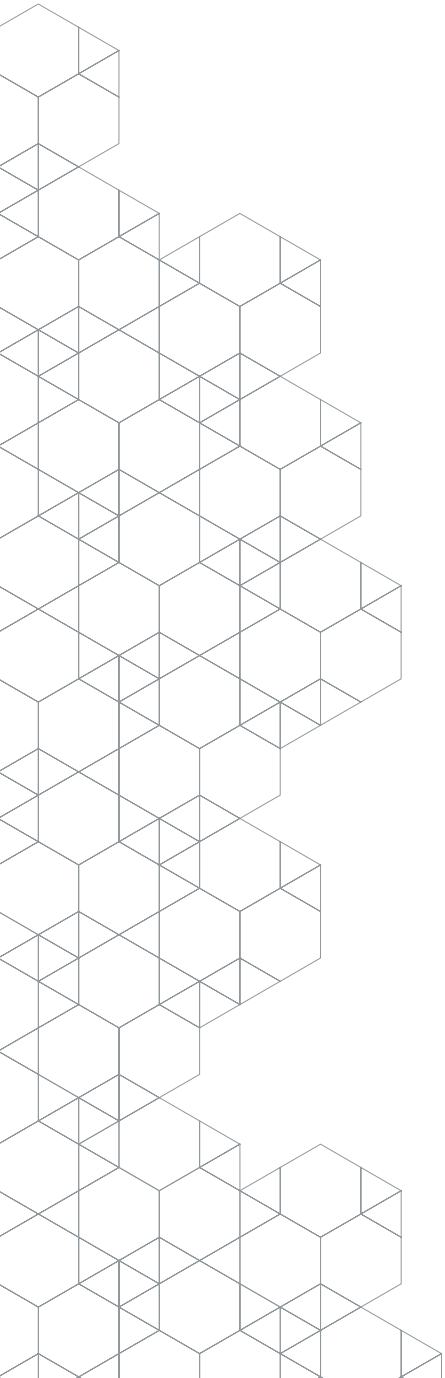

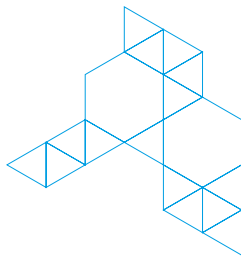
